Bards Introduction:

While I was doing research for the 2001 Atlas of York I visited most of the estates in the Kingdom and met with a great many of the Kingdom's Heralds, Chroniclers and Bards. After the 2001 Atlas was published, I continued to correspond with many of these individuals on the changing conditions in the Kingdom. It was clear, even then, that forces of discontent were loose among the population. The first clear indication of this attitude was the abortive attempt by the March of Mercia to gain the throne in the fall of 2001. The Crown quickly and firmly quashed this effort, however, rather than ending the discontent, this defeat drove the rebels to attempt even more adventurous plans.

When Sir Wright Bentwood succeeded in forming the Canton of Yorkshire during the winter of 2001-2002, the core was formed around which a rebellion grew. By this time the reports I was receiving from throughout the Kingdom made it clear that open warfare was rapidly becoming inevitable. As the estates' populations were called to arms, I began compiling what information I was receiving into War Bulletins and distributing them to the population. The earliest bulletin was published during the first week of June 2002. I continued to publish updated war bulletins weekly until the fighting ended with a truce during the first week of July 2002. What follows are the four War Bulletins I published, with additional comments on the events following the truce.

Since most of the material was collected second hand, I am sure mistakes will be found in my reporting; for those offended by these errors, I do apologize.

WAR BULLITEN #1

WAR IS NEAR!

Kingdom of York: Reports from heralds throughout the Kingdom of York indicate that the uprising that has been simmering is coming to a boil. The outer Estates are said to be gathering their forces for an attempt to secede from York through force of arms. Thus far those lands nearest to The City of York-the March of Tir De Righ and the Canton of Lancaster are supporting the Crown. Also lining up behind the King and Queen are Estates, centered on the Barony of Coer Valient, along the south coast.

KING RALLYS TROUPS!

City of York: The King, Sir Elric Meladius, is said to have given up all hope of ending the disturbances peacefully. He is rallying Loyalist Forces to the cause of the Crown. Archers and Knights are directed to assemble in the Capital City of York. Rumor has it that this Army will be used against the Canton of Yorkshore, the Barony of Westhaven and House Glen Na Gault.

ARMY GATHERS IN MIDLANDS!

City of Sheffield: A Loyalist Army is gathering in Sheffield in the Estate of Thistledown. The Marquis Sir Killian Oaksblood has announced the formation of York's Army of the Midlands and is collecting archers and swordsmen for an attack south into the March of Mercia.

KING'S GUARDS LEAVE NOTTINGHAM!

Castle Nottingham: The Kings Own Guardsmen have left Nottingham and marched to join the King's Army in the City of York. The Sheriff of Nottingham, Illura Llywelyn, has only the Castle and Estate Guards left to protect the King's Estates.

QUEEN GATHERS FORCES!

City of Southampton: The Queen of York, Dame Skye O'Mally was on a scheduled visit to family estates in Coer Valient and House Lasrock when the trouble first erupted. She has taken command of the Loyalist Forces in Southern York. Rapier troops in particular are being assembled in Southampton.

ESTATES IN REVOLT!

Newcastle Upon Tyne: The Canton of Yorkshore is in revolt and has been joined by the March of Mercia and the Canton of Sidhe, forming the Castillian Alliance. Swordsmen, led by Viceroy Sir Wright Bentwood are gathering in Glen na Gault. It is expected that they will attack York through the Estates of Dame Brejenne.

EASTERN MERCIA RISES!

City of Lincoln: The Marquis of Mercia, Sir Olav ye Wight, has left his personnel estates, north of the Humber, to lead the forces of Eastern Mercia. A mixed force of Vikings and bowmen are being readied to oppose York's Army of the Midlands that is currently forming in Sheffield.

CANTON OF SIDHE PREPARED!

City of Penzance: "The Corsairs of Penzance are ready for War!" declares Vicereine Ygrane. She has a small group of rapier armed professionals who look forward to the chance to plunder the Royal Estates east of Sidhe. Even if they are unable to defeat the Queens troops in a head-to-head battle, they can be expected to tie up significant numbers of York's forces.

WALES REMAINS AN UNKNOWN!

Barony of Cambria: Rumors from Wales and Western Mercia hint that the Baron Sir Kreig Zepherlyst is forming an Army in the mountains of central Wales. The isolation of the area has combined with the actions of local witches to severely limit the information that is coming out of the region.

GUILDS DEVIDED!

Free City of London: Historian Dame Cerridwyn Emalia reports that the members of the Mercenary Guild and the Corsairs are appearing in about equal numbers on both sides of the revolt. To this point, neither side has been able to fund a contract for the full support of either Guild.

ODDS NEAR EVEN!

Free City of London: The Bookmakers Guild reports that betting shoppes are quoting near even odds on the outcome of the Castillian Revolution. The Headmaster of the Guild explains "Numbers appear to be on the side of York, but there are so many estates in revolt, in such widespread locations, that the Rebels only have to get lucky and win an isolated battle to make the revolution a success. Once any one area becomes independent the effect will snowball and can't be stopped. The real fight is going to be over who winds up owning what. Now THAT fight will get ugly."

WAR BULLITEN #2

KING DECLARES WAR!

The Kingdom of York: His Most Royal Majesty, Sir Elric Meladius, King of York, By the Grace of God, Defender of the Realm, does hereby Announce and Declare the Canton of Yorkshore, the Canton of Sidhe and the March of Mercia to be in a State of Rebellion against the Lawful Rule of Their King. All Knights and Armsmen of the Realm are Ordered and Directed to Arm Themselves and Suppress this Insult to the Crown.

DUCHY OF CASTILLES FORMED!

City of Newcastle: Viceroy Sir Wright Bentwood has announced that the alliance of Yorkshore, Sidhe and Mercia has formed the new Duchy of Castilles. Other details of the alliance are yet to be worked out.

ARCHERS RALLY TO KING!

City of York: The King continues to collect a strong Army near the City of York. Sources close to the Crown say that this will be termed the "Army of the North". It will march east to the sea, then north along the coast and into the heartland of Yorkshore. An encampment has been growing east of the city to shelter men and supplies. It was there that Sir Nikademus Fiend was found to be in command of the Kings Royal Archers. Says he "The King's archers will fill the skies with their arrows. The rebels can not stand against us. This whole thing will be over in time to drink mead at the Midsummer Festival."

ROYAL ARMY GATHERS IN THISTLEDOWN!

City of Sheffield: Viceroy Sir Killian Oaksblood continues to gather Knights and retainers for a drive south into Mercia. This force is being called the "Army of the Midlands". Sir Killian has dispatched scouts, led by Sir Gavon McAllister, to find favorable lines of march. Says Sir Killian "Mercia has not the Steel to withstand us."

SIR RAFFE GATHERS HOUSEHOLD GUARDS!

Village of Penrth: Sir Raffie Cunningham has summoned the Household Guards of his Estates and Tir De Righ to form an Army for the defense of the Estates of Dame Brejenne Cunningham. Growls the crusty Sir Raff "We're tossing these upstarts out of our Estates and back where they came from."

SIR OLAV CONFIDENT!

City of Lincoln: Asked how Castilles can stand against the vast numbers of York, the Marquees of Mercia, Sir Olav, declares "Tis not just through force of arms, but through the Fine Art of Craftiness that we will confound the minions of York."

ODDS CHANGE!

Free City of London: Following Sir Olav's statement, the Bookmakers Guild announces the odds of the Castillian Rebellion succeeding have fallen from 3 to 1 down to 7 to 1.

QUEENS SWORDS CALLED OUT!

City of Southampton: The Queen, Dame Skye O'Malley, has called To Arms the Queens Royal Swords. This unit is composed of some of the best Lady Swordsmen in the Kingdom. They have pledged themselves to the defense of the Queen. These forces are among those being gathered by the Queen to form York's Army of the South.

PRESSGANG OUT!

City of Penzance: A pressgang, operating from the local pub "The Rock", and led by Lt. Sir Alejandro Vergara, is scouring the nightspots of Sidhe for Corsairs and Armsmen. Vicereine Ygrane swears "Our forces are certain to depart Sidhe in June".

WE WILL HOLD!

Newcastle Castle: Supported by the Household forces of Glen na Gault and Sir Amador de la Hoya, Viceroy Sir Bentwood Wright stoutly maintains that the revolutionary forces of Canton Yorkshore will Prevail. "With our strong castles, we can hold against the Kings Northern Army while our Southern Allies lead our cause to Victory".

ODDS CHANGE!

Free City of London: Following Sir Wright's announcement, the Bookmakers Guild reduced the odds for success by Castille from 7 to 1 downward to 9 to 1.

WITCHCRAFT AT WORK!

Barony of Cambria: The spell "Fog of War" has been cast over the Barony and central Wales by the Witches of Mercia led by Countess Dame Ana Llwyn. Rumors continue to be whispered that the Baron Sir Kreig is there and forming an Army, however, travelers have been unable to enter or leave the Barony.

HOUSE MACBRUCE QUILTS REVOLT!

Village of Kelso: In a surprise move, Sir Bleyz MacBruce, Lord of House MacBruce has quit the Barony of Westhaven and the rebellion and has declared for the King. The Baron of Westhaven, Sir Aleric Thorne, has announced that he will march on the defecting house and swears to return it to the Barony.

SHIPS RECALLED!

Port of Yarmouth: It has just been discovered that the Barony of Bristole and House Giovanni summoned all available shipping to congregate in Yarmouth Harbor in preparation for the rebellion. This summons was quietly made over six weeks ago and thus explains the reports of large numbers of ships anchoring in the harbor.

BETTING HEAVY!

Free City of London: The Bookmakers Guild reports that betting on the Castillian Revolution has been heavy, with the majority of the bets backing York to suppress the Rebellion. Especially noteworthy was the report of several boxes of what was said to be gold coin that was delivered to the London Bookmakers Guild by House Giovanni on behalf of certain of their Sicilian Business Associates.

Thus ends this bulletin, as I take up arms on behalf of March Mercia and leave my Estate to join the Army of East Mercia.

WAR BULLITEN #3

SCARBOROUGH CAPTURED!

City of Scarborough: The City fell this morning to advance forces of the Northern Army of York led by King Elric. After marching down the River Ouse and eastward to the North Sea, King Elric's forces turned and moved north along the coast. Arriving at Scarborough their overwhelming force quickly compelled the surrender of the city and castle.

ESTATE SEIZED!

City of York: Following tradition, the King's Herald, Squire Gilbert announced that the City and Castle of Scarborough, along with other Estates and Lands of the Known Rebel, Marquis Sir Olav ye Wight, have been seized and are declared forfeit to the Crown.

OLAV REPLIES!

City of Lincoln: Notified of the loss of his Estates, Sir Olav took time from commanding the Army of Eastern Mercia to answer questions about what he would do next. His reply "The first thing I will do is change my Theme Song from Scarborough Fair to a song that will do justice to the King's Actions. Something that could be played on the pit pipe would do nicely."

CASTLE DURHAM PREPARES FOR WAR!

Durham Castle: Sir Amador de la Hoya and the household troops of Glen na Gault have occupied Durham Castle and are rapidly preparing it for war. Say Sir Amador "If the King attacks Yorkshere, he will have to come through us."

GUILDS WORKING OVERTIME!

Free City of London: The minister of the joint Council of the Arts and Crafts Guilds, Toireasa McBride, announced today that Guilds throughout the Kingdom are working overtime to support the war effort. "The armies need everything from clothing and weapons to food and drink. We will see that they are well supported as you never know which efforts will bring victory."

NOTTINGHAM TAKEN BY CASTILLES!

Nottingham Castle: A group of Mercia's Viking Raiders, led by Count Sir Thorvald Isblod, has stormed and taken Nottingham Castle, Capital of the Kings Estates. Rumor has it that the castle guards were first surprised by a small group of Mercian Rangers, led by Marquessa Etaine, and disguised as little old ladies. The Rangers appear to have been let into the back of the castle by the Sheriff of Nottingham, who is known to be deeply in debt to the Marquessa.

ODDS CHANGE!

Free City of London: Following the loss of Scarborough to the King, the odds being given for a Castillian victory dropped to 20 to 1. They stayed at this level for one day, then climbed back to 12 to 1 with the news that Castilles had captured Nottingham Castle.

CASTILLES BETTING ON VICTORY!

City of Norwich: Lady Zabrina de Vine, Sire of House Giovani, has announced that gold collected from all of the Estates of Castilles has been pooled and wagered on a victory by Castilles. Having foreknowledge of the intended raid on Nottingham, Lady Zabrina was able to place the bets in London at odds of 20 to 1. Three of London's premier bookmakers have joined in covering the Castillian wager. Said one "At these odds, if Castilles wins I may be back selling fruit from a pushcart." Asked the source of the collected funds, Lady Zabrina replied "Let us just say we were very careful in calculating our tax bills this spring."

SIDHE MOVES EAST!

City of Plymouth: The Army of Sidhe has marched east and taken the City of Plymouth. There, Viceriene Ygrane briefly halted her forces, before marching east and seizing Exeter. Ygrane says she intends to continue the march toward Southampton. Meanwhile, Corsair ships commanded by Lt. Sir Alejandro Veragara have left the Port of Penzance and are pacing the movement of the Army while fending off raids by House Lasrock's Privateers.

QUEEN MOVES WEST!

City of Poole: Queen Skye has moved York's Southern Army out of Southampton and has marched west and through the City of Poole. "Ygrane leads an army of schoolchildren. They will never stand up to the professional swordsmen in My Army." predicts the Queen. York's Army of the South is now believed to be in Dorchester and still moving west. Privateer ships from House Lasrock have also moved west and along the coast, to support the Queen. They have reported several encounters with the Corsairs of Sidhe.

YORKSHORE SPLITS FORCES!

City of Newcastle: Yorkshore has split its' Army. The larger of the two forces is marching south toward Durham Castle and is led by Viceroy Sir Wright Bentwood. A smaller detachment, led by Sir Alaric Thorne, has moved west and occupied the lands of House MacBruce after a short, but fierce battle. Sir Bleyz MacBruce is said to have fled north and joined his forces with a small Scottish Army of York led by Baroness Sionna Wyld, somewhere in the Estate of House Craigh Na Dunn.

KING MOVES NORTH!

City of Scarborough: King Elric has marched York's Army of the North from the City of Scarborough, along the coast, and has crossed the River Tees. He has announced that he will assault the rebels holding Durham Castle within the next week.

FLEET SAILS!

Port of Yarmouth: Commanded by Baron Sir Giacomo di Verona, the Fleet of East Mercia has left port and sailed north. Rumors abound that it will join with a Viking Fleet, led by Sir Olav, at the Mouth of the Humber.

NOTTINGHAM UNDER SIEGE!

City of Nottingham: Sir Killian has marched York's Army of the Midlands south from Sheffield and along the Military Trail to Nottingham, where Sir Gavon has taken over a pub for use as Army Headquarters. Sir Killian has declared Nottingham Castle to be under siege and proclaims "First we will retake the Castle, then we will march into Mercia." It is believed that at least one attempt to take the castle by storm has been made.

FOG LIFTS!

Along the Bristol Channel: The spell "Fog of War" lifted briefly this day to reveal Castilles' Army of West Mercia marching south rapidly toward the City of Bristol and the Estates of House Numenus.

War Bulletin # 4

SIEGE BROKEN!

City of Nottingham: The Siege of Nottingham Castle by Sir Killian and York's Army of the Midlands was broken when a relief column commanded by Sir Olav fought its way through to the Castle. Mercian Bowmen led by Alfred of Clophill and Bieninstick protected the flanks of Sir Olav's force. Since Sir Olav was widely rumored to be at sea, it is clear that a subterfuge has been committed.

MACBRUCE RETAKEN!

Village of Kelso: A contingent of York's archers supporting York's Scottish troops devastated the Yorkshores forces occupying House Mac Bruce, allowing Sir Bleyze Mac Bruce to reclaim his estate for York.

HOUSE NUMENUS DECLARES SUPPORT FOR CASTILLES!

City of Bristol: With the arrival of Castilles' Army of West Mercia in Bristol, capital of House Numenus, Sir Hawthorne Perigord has proclaimed the support of his House for Castilles. His household troops have joined Castilles', marching southeast toward Southampton.

TWO BATTLES AT DURHAM CASTLE!

Durham Castle: The long anticipated battle between the York's Army of the North and the Army of Yorkshores has occurred. It began with the forces of Yorkshores holding Durham Castle. Using their superiority in archers to cover the attack, Sir Robin ap Nudd led York footmen and seized the curtain wall of the Castle. The inner courtyard was then captured in an attack led by the King Himself, Sir Elric of York. Then Viceroy, Sir Wright of Yorkshores arrived with additional infantry from Newcastle. Led by Sir Magnus McNair they stormed and recaptured the Castle. A small contingent of York's swordsmen made a final and valiant stand in the castle. Lady Alyssa is known to be the sole survivor and has been taken to Newcastle as a valued prisoner of Yorkshores. With the fall of Durham Castle, King Elric has taken his remaining troops south and has erected a line of fortifications along the south bank of the River Tees.

SOUTHAMPTON OVERRUN! BATTLE ON POOLE DOCKS!

City of Southampton: While Queen Skye and York's Southern Army were occupied facing the forces of Sidhe, an Castillian Army from Western Mercia marched swiftly on Southampton. Led by Baron Sir Kreig they passed freely through the Estate of House Numenus. From there they overran the York Estates of Sir Elric Meladius and the Barony of Couer Valient and fought their way into Southampton. Sir Hawthorne personally led the attack that stormed Southampton Castle. Cut off from Southampton, Queen Skye retreated to Poole, with forces from Sidhe in pursuit, and began using Lasrock Privateers to evacuate her forces from the Port of Poole to the Isle of Wight. While the evacuation

was underway, additional Castillian forces arrived from Southampton. Castilles' combined force was then led by Lady Q in an assault across the bridge leading to the Poole docks. A valiant counterattack by Sir John MacLeod delayed the Castillians while the remainder of York's force escaped. Sir John was last seen vanishing beneath a wave of Castillian swordsmen. His surcoat was found under a stack of bodies and a mangled corpse was identified as Sir John. It was carefully boxed and shipped to his home. A wake for Sir John will be held at the Dunvegan City Shrine, Isle of Skye.

ISLE OF WIGHT BLOCKADED!

Isle of Wight: The island is owned by House Lasrock and is currently occupied by Queen Skye and the surviving members of York's Southern Army. The small fleet of Lasrock Privateers who normally guard access to the Isle, has been defeated by Corsair ships from Sidhe. Meanwhile, a Mercian Fleet led by Baron Sir Giacomo has placed the island under a close naval blockade. Since this fleet was last seen sailing north from Yarmouth there is considerable speculation as to how it was able to slip south, undetected, and through the English Channel.

TRUCE DECLARED!

CASTILLES VICTORIOUS!

City of Lincoln: While it will be some time before all of the details are known, it appears that Castilles has won a Resounding Victory. It is certain that their forces were entirely successful in the Midlands and South of England. Reports from the Northern Estates remain mixed, with both sides claiming victories.

ARMIES WELL SUPPLIED!

Free City of London: Torrissa McBride, Minister of the Joint Council of the Arts and Crafts Guilds has announced that both York and Castilles spent lavishly to insure that their armies in the field received adequate supplies. In the end, it would appear that the forces of Castilles obtained a slight advantage. It is worth noting that the local truce celebration began with a stock of sweet cherry mead provided by Lord Gigantus Danada of Mercia.

BOOKMAKERS MISSING!

Free City of London: Several members of the Bookmakers Guild have disappeared from the City of London and are actively being sought by Businessmen from Sicily regarding a number of wagers placed on a Castillian Victory. Another notable of the guild was recently seen behind a pushcart of fruit, the result of wagers placed by House Giovanni on behalf of Castilles. Lady Dame Zabrina de Vine is busy auditing the books of three betting shoppes that are now owned jointly by the Duchy of Castilles and House Giovanni.

DUKE AND DUCHESS ANNOUNCED!

Cantons of Yorkshore and Sidhe: It has been announced that the new Duchy of Castilles will be jointly ruled by Duke Sir Wright Bentwood, Viceroy of Yorkshore and Duchess Ygrane, Vicereine of Sidhe. A Coronation Banquet is planned for July 20th, to be paid

for largely with the successful wagers that had been placed on a Castillian Victory.

KING ANNOUNCES ESTATES MEETING!

City of York: King Elric of York has announced a formal meeting of The Estates of York, to take place on July 13th. Estate affiliations will be reconciled and land captured during the war will be awarded to those who have faithfully supported the Crown during the recent period of unpleasantness.

2002 ATLAS OF YORK CANCELLED!

City of Cambridge: The editor and publishers of the 2001 Atlas of York ask that owners of the 2001 edition please retain it. Events of the Castillian Revolution have conspired to preclude the publication of a 2002 edition of the Atlas; instead, an addendum will be issued to the 2001 printing, to detail the events of the Rebellion and to document the new political boundaries and Estate associations.

SHERIFF NEEDED!

City of York: Although the Kings Estates in Nottingham are still in the hands of Castilles, King Elric has vowed to replace the previous Sheriff, who so recently defected to Castilles. Applicants for appointment to position of the King's Sheriff for Nottingham may apply at the Court of York. A substantial reward is being offered for the return of the previous Sheriff to York... No Questions Asked!

PARTIES TO MEET!

Free City of London: The Bishop of London has announced that he will sponsor a meeting between that various parties involved in the recent War, with the hope that a peaceful settlement might be reached. Further information is expected.

Afterwards:

Some weeks have passed since a truce was declared. Representatives from both York and Castille have met in London. Their efforts have resulted in The Treaty of London, establishing peace throughout the land and setting the boundaries of the two Kingdoms.

Foremost among the points covered by the treaty include the boundary established between York and the March of Mercia. Starting on the North Sea and the Humber it follows the River Trent up to the City of Stoke-on-Trent. A line goes north from there to the River Dane, then down that river to the mouth of the Mersey. Land immediately south of this line belongs to Mercia and Castilles; land immediately north of this boundary belongs to York.

North of York, it was agreed that the River Tees would form the southern border of Yorkshire, however, no agreement could be reached for the western and northern boundaries. Each side will continue to hold the land it occupied at the time of the truce. This leaves several border disputes unresolved and promises to be the cause of further conflict.

Word has reached York and Castilles that Castilles has been formally accepted into the Adrian Empire as The Duchy of Castilles on July 6, 2002.

When truce was declared, Castilles was in possession of the Kings Estates and Nottingham Castle, while in the south Queen Skye was blockaded on the Isle of Wight. The agreement that returned all lands north of the Trent River to York also returned Nottingham to the Crown and allowed the Queen and her forces safe transit from The Isle of Wight. The Isle then became the property of Castilles and has been declared the Estates of the Crown of Castilles.

For outstanding bravery, while storming the Castles of Durham and Southampton, Duke Wright has awarded Sir Magnus and Sir Hawthorne the title of Lord of the Court. Each has been granted estates in the south of England as reward for their service to the Duchy, although both remain citizens of York.

Friends of Lady Alyssa, York's heroin of the Battle of Durham Castle, will be pleased to learn that her ransom has been paid and she has returned safely to her family.

The Court of York was most shocked this week when Sir John MacLeod rode in through the South Gate. He has explained that he was overwhelmed and captured during the Battle of Poole. After he was bound, his surcoat was removed and tossed onto a pile of the dead. He was sent to Southampton Castle dressed as a common prisoner. There he was presented to the Baroness Serelle Llwyn, gave his parole, and was granted the freedom of the castle. Once his wounds had healed enough to permit travel, he rode to the City of York. When told of his funeral he declared that it was grossly unfair that he had to miss what was described as a fine wake on his behalf. He also said that he understood that he

had a most impressive grave waiting for him, but felt that he could put off visiting it for another 50 years or so. He will be collecting funds to pay his parole.

A merchant ship has docked in Yarmouth after passage from Naples. The ships Captain reports that a number of former members of London's prestigious Bookmakers Guild have been observed working off their debts to certain Sicilian Businessmen while plying the oars of galleys belonging to the City of Naples.

The Bishop of London has announced that, in compliance with the terms of the Treaty of London, both subdivisions have formally announced the appointment of Ambassadors. The Bishop stated that it had been hoped that this would be a gesture of peace and good will...but noted the appointments named did not reinforce this hope.
